## OUR LEARNING THIS TERM

**Maths:** This term for maths we have been learning how to use arrays to help us solve multiplication problems and some basic divisions.

**English:** In English we have been reading *The Day the Crayons Quit* and have been writing for different purposes such as diary entries, recounts and poetry.

**Science:** For Science we have been learning about everyday materials and their uses. We have carried out experiments including the suitability of paper boats.

**DT:** For dt we have been learning about food. We have tried and tasted different foods and described what we could taste.

**History:** In History we have been learning about key people such as Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale.

**Computing:** In computing we have been learning about coding and using algorithms.

## Key facts we are learning this term:

Mary Seacole was born on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of November 1805. She is most famous for travelling to Crimea in 1855 to help care for British soldiers wounded in the war. The soldiers even called her 'Mother Seacole'.

Florence Nightingale was born on the 12<sup>th</sup> of May 1820. She served as a manager and trainer of nurses during the Crimean War.
