WHAT WE HAVE BEEN LEARNING THIS TERM

Learning now for future success.

This term has been an exciting and interesting one. We have had a new King being crowned and children have learnt much about our new monarch, we learnt about William Shakespeare during World Shakespeare Day and we have had an amazing visit to the Tower of London. We have learnt a huge range of things across the curriculum whilst getting ready to sit our Year 2 SATs tests.

The children have worked extremely hard this term and they have achieved many things. The learning has been pitched high and they have all shown capability and enjoyment.

OUR LEARNING THIS TERM

Maths: This term for maths we have been learning how to use arrays to help us solve multiplication problems and some basic divisions. We have also been learning about mass, capacity and volume.

English: In English we have been reading *The Twelfth Night* and learnt many things about William Shakespeare. We have been learning to write newspaper reports, recounts and poetry.

Science: For Science we have been learning about plants and animals. We have learnt about different habitats, around us and in other places.

Art: For art children have been studying Mark Rise and creating their own digital art using Paint on iPads. They have been thoroughly enjoying this.

Geography: In Geography, children have been learning all about rivers including the parts of a river, when a river begins and ends and how rivers are formed.

Computing: In computing we have been learning how to make our own music—we have learnt about pulse, rhythm, tempo and pitch.

- River Severn is the longest river in the UK
- The beginning of a river is called source and the end is the mouth
- Rivers have many uses
- Canals are human features and have different uses
