



RSHE Curriculum Delivery Plan – Autumn 2020 – Summer 2021.

The planned delivery for RSHE has changed following COVID 19 and the limitations that this brought to parent consultation. This delivery shows our plans for PSHCE (pre statutory guidance) across the year, moving to RSHE in Summer 2021, where we will be obligated to fulfil the RSHE Statutory guidance.



Please note that although this offers some guide to PSHCE and RSHE the primary curriculum is cross curricular by nature. PSHCE and RSHE subjects, in particular, feature in all lessons and systems in the school, for example science, Physical Education, behaviour policy, anti-bullying policy etc...

Ofsted, September 2020

‘The statutory guidance on RSHE (DfE, 2019) was expected to come into effect, and school should have been inspected by Ofsted with regard to it, from September 2020. However, Covid 19 has meant many schools are behind with their implementation and the DfE and Ofsted are taking this into account. As from January 2021 Ofsted may comment on a school’s readiness to teach statutory RSHE, including how they teach inclusion and equality (including LGBT+ relationships). Their comments will not affect the grading of the school.

From summer term 2021, Ofsted will inspect to the Statutory Guidance (DfE, 2019) and a school may be rated ‘requires improvement’ if their RSHE is found lacking or they have not carried out quality, and inclusive parental consultation.’
