WHAT ARE WE LEARNING THIS TERM?


Welcome back,

What a wonderful start to the term after a very strange few months. The year 4 children have responded brilliantly, have settled back into the school life following such a long time away from school. They are following all the new rules about sanitizing; hand washing and using certain stairways.

We will be learning about the Romans in history this term; finding out about why the Romans invaded; what the impact and legacy of the Romans was and still is. We will even be learning some Latin!

Build 3D models of Landmarks e.g., colosseum and pantheon



Geog – Make a paper Mache Globe with your Family,
